Clemens Jäger

Professor Dr. Dr. habil. Clemens Jäger has worked for FOM University (www.fom.de) since 2004 and has held a full-time professorship at the University Center in Essen since February 2010. The economist with a doctorate and habilitation also heads the FOM International Office (since 2009) and is Dean of General Business Administration I (since 2012). The Dean comprises around 22,000 students, approximately 150 professors and is responsible for the implementation of various Master's and Bachelor's programs at more than 30 FOM locations throughout Germany. He also lectures at the University of Sopron (Hungary), UCAM Universidad Católica San Antonio de Murcia (Spain) and Fontys University of Applied Sciences (Netherlands), among others. In his functions he is responsible for various national and international cooperation's between companies and the FOM University. Especially the maintenance and continuous development of these cooperation's is one of his primary fields of activity. In the context of his research activities, the graduate economist and computer scientist deals, among other things, with early warning indicators in the field of finance, restructuring and reorganization of companies.
