


Master's Degree in

Scholarships

This master program offers **15** academic scholarships. All requirements should be submitted before **June 30th 2023** with the requirements as the following:

- Bachelor's degree (GPA 3.0/4.0. or 8/10)
- B2 English Proficiency
- A Short Essay around the issue of Tolerance and Peace.
- A Curriculum Vitae or Resume

- An Academic Transcript
- A Motivation Letter
- Two Reference Letters

Prepare the following documents and send them via email to admissions@ucam.edu and UCAM Enrollment Advisor in your <u>country</u>:

- Language proficiency certificate from this <u>list</u>. Any other English certificate will be evaluated individually. For students who completed the bachelor degree from the US, UK or any English-speaking countries, language proficiency certificate is not required. For any other countries, UCAM also accepts letters from the university certifying that the medium/language of instruction is English.
- Scanned biopage of your valid passport.
- Bachelor's academic transcript and degree certificate
- Statement of Purpose/Motivational Letter
- Curriculum Vitae
