

Incompatibilities, extension of enrollment, electives and Spanish certificates for the academic year 2024/25

Bachelor's Degree in Dentistry



1. Incompatibilities¹

The Practicum subjects belonging to Module 5: Adult clinic (12 ECTS) and Pediatric clinic (12 ECTS), have enrollment conditioned to the passing of:

- Dental Radiology and Radioprotection (6 ECTS).
- Legal and forensic dentistry (6 ECTS).
- Ergonomics, Dental Materials and Instrumentation (6 ECTS).
- Pharmacology, Anesthesia and Reanimation (6 ECTS).
- Preventive and Community Dentistry (6 ECTS).
- Introduction to Dentistry, Management and Dental Practice Planning (6 ECTS).
- Oral Surgery (12 ECTS).
- Dental Pathology and Therapy I (12 ECTS).
- Prosthodontics I (12 ECTS).
- Oral Medicine (12 ECTS).
- Dental Pathology and Therapy II (6 ECTS).
- Prosthodontics II (6 ECTS).
- Occupational Pathology in Dentistry (6 ECTS).
- Pediatric Dentistry (6 ECTS).
- Dental Treatment of Patients with Special Needs (6 ECTS).
- Periodontics (6 ECTS).

2. Extension of enrollment

Enrollment may not be extended for the second semester for the following subjects:

- Sports Dentistry (6 ECTS).
- Dentistry and Dietetics (6 ECTS).

- Theology (6 ECTS).
- End of Degree Project (6 ECTS).

3. Electives

- Limited to a maximum number of 20 students (Spanish) and 14 (bilingual).
- Call for enrollment based on academic record.

4. End of Degree Project

Enrollment conditioned to the previous passing of 210 ECTS credits.

5. Spanish language certificates²

The Spanish language certificates accepted by the Degree are DELE, SIELE and Escuela Superior de Idiomas de la UCAM.

Enrollment for Oral Surgery

- **Students with a B2 certificate of Spanish.** They can register for this subject at the beginning of the course as usual.
- **Students with B1 Spanish certificate or without certificate.** They must sign the conditional enrollment document for this subject where they commit themselves to obtain the B2 certificate of Spanish before the beginning of the internship with patients in the second semester. If the student does not obtain the certificate corresponding to the minimum language level required, he/she will be disenrolled at the end of the first term, losing the grades obtained to date and not being eligible for reimbursement of the registration fee.

- **Students with a B2 certificate of Spanish.** They can register for these subjects at the beginning of the course as usual.
- **Students with B1 Spanish certificate or without certificate.** They cannot register for these subjects at the beginning of the course. They may extend their registration in February if they have obtained the B2 Spanish language certificate during the first term.
