The implementation of the new curriculum of the Degree in Physical Activity and Sports Sciences will be implemented progressively year by year, following the sequence and structure detailed in the following chronogram, which includes both the sequence of implementation of the new Degree, as well as the process of extinction of the previous Degree (BOE 03/06/2010):

PROCEDURE FOR ADAPTATION TO THE NEW STUDY PLAN BY STUDENTS COMING FROM THE PREVIOUS PLAN.

Year 2022/2023

The new syllabus of the Degree in Physical Activity and Sports Sciences: It will be implemented in the first academic year, and 380 new places will be offered in the new degree.

Previous syllabus of the Degree in Physical Activity and Sports Sciences (BOE 03/06/2010): No new places will be offered for the first year, so the extinction of the syllabus published in the BOE 03/06/2010 leading to the degree of Graduate in Physical Activity and Sports Sciences begins, with the exceptions of durability of up to four calls for first year subjects, to be distributed between the academic years 2022/2023 and 2023/2024. Teaching activity is maintained in the second, third and fourth years.

Year 2023/2024

The new syllabus of the Degree in Physical Activity and Sports Sciences: 380 new places will be offered in the Degree, it will be taught in the first academic year, and it will be implemented in the second academic year.

Previous syllabus of the Degree in Physical Activity and Sports Sciences (BOE 03/06/2010): No new admission places will be offered for the previous curriculum of the Degree in Physical Activity and Sport Sciences (BOE 03/06/2010), no first enrollments will be offered for the basic and compulsory subjects corresponding to the second year, included in the syllabus leading to the Degree in Physical Activity and Sport Sciences (BOE 03/06/2010), with the exceptions of durability of up to four calls for second year subjects, to be distributed between the academic years 2023/2024 and 2024/2025. Teaching activity is maintained in the third and fourth years.

Year 2024/2025

The new syllabus of the Degree in Physical Activity and Sports Sciences: 380 new places will be offered in the Degree, the first and second academic year will be taught, and the third academic year will be implemented.

Previous syllabus of the Degree in Physical Activity and Sports Sciences (BOE 03/06/2010): No new admission places will be offered for the Degree in Physical Activity and Sport Sciences (BOE 03/06/2010), no first enrollments will be offered for the basic and compulsory subjects corresponding to the third year, included in the study plan leading to the degree of Graduate Degree in Physical Activity and Sport Sciences (BOE 03/06/2010), with the exceptions of endurance of up to four calls for third year subjects, to be distributed between the academic years 2024/2025 and 2025/2026.

Students with subjects pending in the first year who have not passed the exams in the scheduled calls, if they wish to continue their studies must continue them with the new plans, through the recognition or adaptation of the credits passed.

Year 2025/2026

The new curriculum of the Bachelor's Degree in Physical Activity and Sports Sciences: 380 new places will be offered in the Bachelor's Degree, and all academic years of the degree will be taught.

Previous syllabus of the Degree in Sciences of Physical Activity and Sport (BOE 03/06/2010): No new admission places will be offered in the Degree in Sciences of Physical Activity and Sport (BOE 03/06/2010), no first enrollments will be offered for the basic, compulsory and optional subjects corresponding to the fourth year, included in the curriculum leading to the degree of Graduate in Sciences of Physical Activity and Sport (BOE 03/06/2010), with the exceptions of durability of up to four calls for fourth year subjects, to be distributed between the academic years 2025/2026 and 2026/2027.

Students with subjects pending in the second year who have not passed the exams in the scheduled calls, if they wish to continue their studies must continue them with the new plans, through the recognition or adaptation of the credits passed

Year 2026/2027

Students with subjects pending in the third year who have not passed the exams at the scheduled dates, if they wish to continue their studies must continue them under the new plans, through the recognition or adaptation of the credits passed.

Year 2027/2028

Students with subjects pending in the fourth year who have not passed the exams in the scheduled dates, if they wish to continue their studies, they must continue them under the new plans, through the recognition or adaptation of the credits passed.

The process of adaptation of students of the previous Degree in Sciences of Physical Activity and Sport (BOE 03/06/2010) to the new Degree in Sciences of Physical Activity and Sport at the Catholic University San Antonio modified, in accordance with current regulations, will be carried out at the request of the students themselves, ensuring that there is no prejudice to them. To this effect, the table of equivalences, for the adaptation of the subjects of the previous curriculum of the Degree in Sciences of Physical Activity and Sport (BOE 03/06/2010), to the new curriculum leading to the degree of Graduate in Sciences of Physical Activity and Sport is listed in the following table
